Procedures for Sponsoring an Oneg

Our Congregation has been missing out on one special opportunity that we can do for one another, that is our sponsoring a Shabbat Oneg/Kiddush luncheon.

It is a simple, yet very important mitzvah you can perform.....it supports our Jewish community by giving of ourselves, our time and our dedication to Congregation Shaar Hashalom.

We have provided several choices in sponsoring an Oneg, complete with kitchen help and Kosher menu choices. All choices will follow our Kosher guidelines for only dairy/parve, and can even be picked up by our kitchen staff for a small fee, if you choose that option. Our friends at Randall's have provided a food list that you may choose from.

Along with the options listed below, the following items will be provided for you:

***Sisterhood Kitchen VP's will be provide: 2 challah, all paper goods, decorations, tablecloths and detailed kitchen procedures .**

***Men's Club will provide bagels for Saturday Kiddush luncheon.**

***Ritual VP's will provide wine/grape juice for both Friday and Saturday.**

There are 3 options listed below:

- 1. Pay \$140 for the setup and cleanup for both Friday and Saturday, plus the price of the food you choose from our menu options. The kitchen help will then pick up your choices from Randall's , for an extra \$10 fee. This option will be the perfect choice if you are unable to attend services; all will be covered for both Friday night and Saturday morning.**
- 2. Pay the \$140 fee for the kitchen help to set up and clean up for both days, but you provide the foods, following our Kosher guidelines. You buy or make the foods and bring them to CSH on Friday afternoon. The kitchen help will then set up and clean up for both days. Again, you have the option of attending or not attending services.**
- 3. This choice involves no kitchen help fee and you bring in your choice of foods. Again, following our Kosher guidelines, you set out the food, enjoy services and visit with friends. After services, you clean up the kitchen and social hall. This option again means you will bring everything in on Friday before Shabbat.**

If you select this choice, there will be step by step kitchen procedures posted in the kitchen. They will be easy to follow, with recommendations for the best ways to set up and clean up our kitchen, allowing you to leave the building as you found it.
